## Unissued Lubiana Designs Reported

One of philately's greatest pleasures lies in the fact that no chapter of history is ever a closed book to the collector.

The set originated in occupied Lubiana (part of Yugoslavia) during World War II, and consists of six different designs in denominations of 4 and 15-lire, each stamp existing in seven colors. They were printed in vertical, set-tenant strips, each strip containing a complete set of six face-different stamps.

A signed and sealed certificate from the Slovenian Philatelic Federation explains that the issue was prepared by the Germans when they took over Lubiana from the demoralized Italians, but was never issued due to the quick collapse of the Nazis and the end of World War II.

The certificate goes on to say that the stamps were designed by a painter, Janez Trpin of Lubiana, and printed at the Tiskarna Ljudske Pravice printing shop in that city, and that "about 500 sets" were run off. They picture Slovenian patriots, one of them being Primoz Trubar, subsequently honored on a stamp issued in B-Zone Trieste after the war.

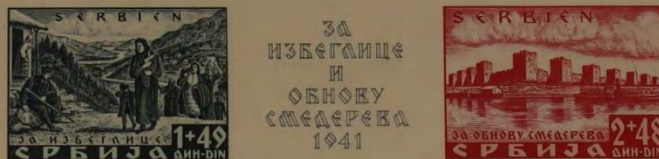

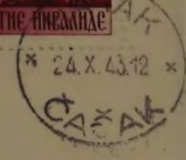




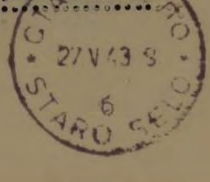
