Francesco Lana de Terzi (1631-1687),
Italian Catholic priest, designer of an airship *and a blind writing alphabet*

Francesco Lana de Terzi (1631-1687)

was an Italian Jesuit priest, mathematician, naturalist and aeronautics pioneer. Having been professor of physics and mathematics at Brescia, he first sketched the concept for a vacuum airship and has been referred to as the Father of Aeronautics

Blind writing alphabet

In his book Prodomo he also introduced an entirely new alphabet for blind people of his own invention. Unlike previous blind writing systems, Lana's alphabet was based on the idea that it did not have to mimic the regular handwritten or printed letters, but had to be based on signs (dashes) that could be recognized by the touch of one's fingers. The one detail which prevented the success of this invention is that Lana failed to understand that dots were more easily recognizable than dashes by the touch. Louis Braille made this fundamental intuition and devised the blind writing alphabet that was named after him.

HISTORIA DEL CLUB DE LEONES



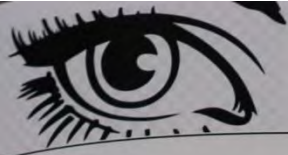
La Asociación Internacional del Club de Leones se inició como el sueño del empresario de Chicago, Melvin Jones. El creyó que los clubes de empresarios locales debían ampliar sus horizontes y preocuparse no sólo por asuntos meramente empresariales, sino también por el bienestar de sus comunidades y del mundo en general.

El grupo al cual pertenecía Jones, "Círculo de negocios de Chicago", estuvo de acuerdo. Después de hacer contacto con grupos similares del país se efectuó una reunión para organizarse el 7 de junio de 1917 en el Hotel La Salle de Chicago. El nuevo grupo tomó como nombre el de uno de los grupos invitados, "La Asociación de Clubes de Leones", y se efectuó una Convención en Dallas en el mes de Octubre de ese mismo año. Se aprobaron los Estatutos, Normas, Objetivos de la Asociación y un Código de Ética.

Entre los Objetivos oficiales adoptados en esos años iniciales, había uno que decía: "Ningun club tendrá como objetivo el mejoramiento financiero de sus miembros". Este objetivo ha permanecido como uno de los principales Estatutos de la Asociación desde entonces.

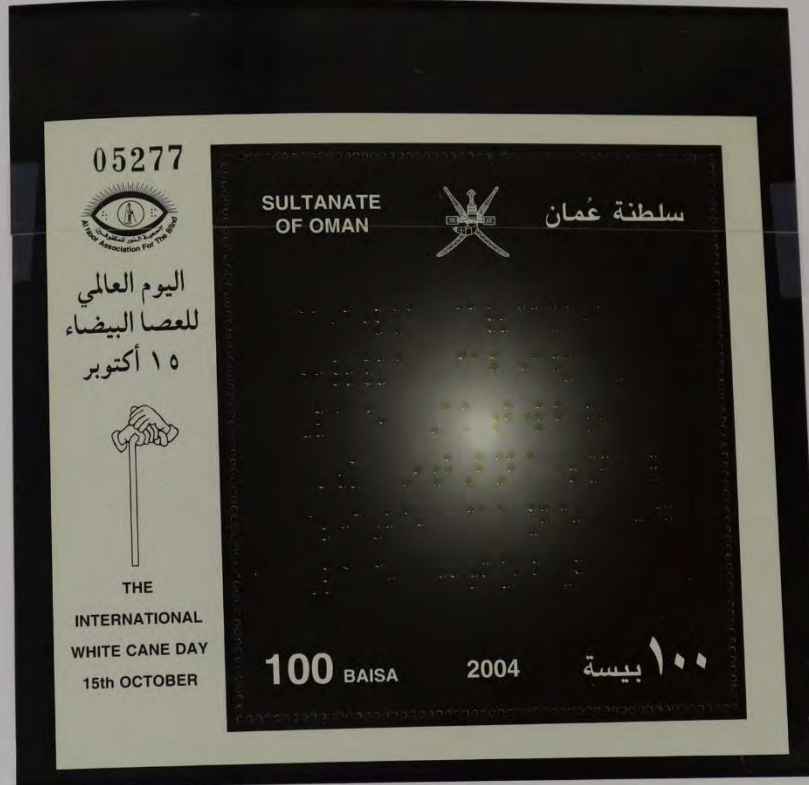
Tres años después de su formación se volvió internacional, cuando se formó el primer Club en Canadá en 1920. Una mayor expansión internacional continuó a medida que se fueron estableciendo clubes, particularmente a lo largo de Europa, Asia y Africa, durante los años 1950 y 60.

Braille

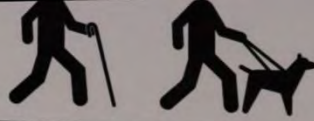
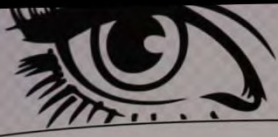
States Parties shall enable persons with disabilities to learn life and social development skills to facilitate their full and equal participation in education and as members of the community. To this end, States Parties shall take appropriate measures, including... facilitating the learning of Braille... (art. 24)

Braille is an important support to education and communication for blind individuals. Braille characters are a formation of six dots in the shape of a rectangle, with up to 63 possible combinations using one or more of the six dots. These dots are embossed onto thick paper by hand or machine and read with the fingers moving across the Braille characters.

Louis Braille devised the system in 1821, and it is now used in every country. The bicentenary of Braille's birth is on 4 January 2009.

Braille is used less frequently today. In some cases, blind children are denied the right to use Braille. It is important, in the era of technology, that blind individuals are not deprived of the right to read and write Braille.

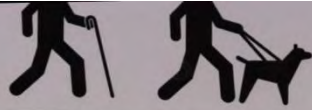

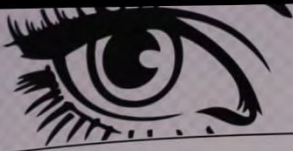
