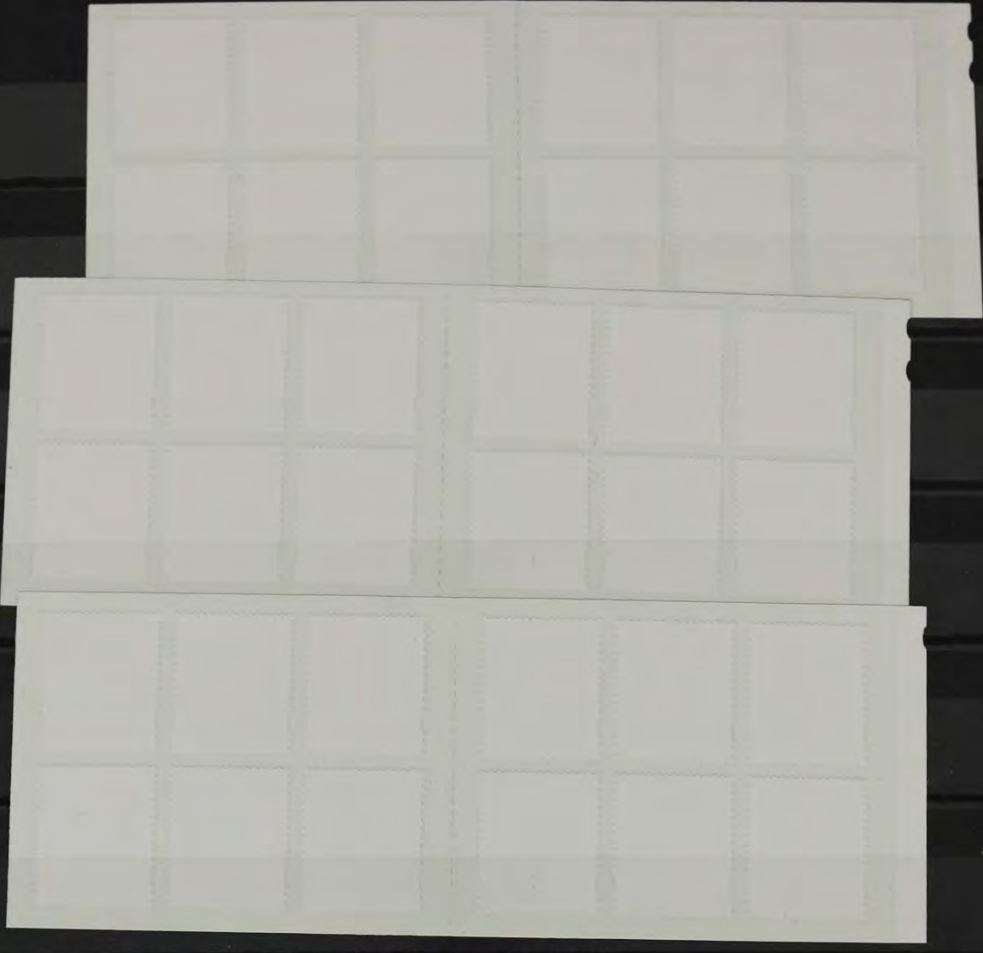

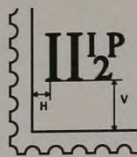

Some facts about Wedgwood

- A first edition copy of the Portland Vase made in the late eighteenth century realised £20,000 at Sotheby's on 30th November 1971 – a world record auction price for an English ceramic.
- Josiah Wedgwood paid the third Duke of Portland £100, a handsome hiring fee in those days, for the loan of the Barberini (or Portland) vase in order to model his famous Jasper reproductions.
- Josiah Wedgwood equipped dairies with his ceramic products – from the tiling for the walls to settling pans for the cream.
- In 1784 Wedgwood made a Jasper chess set. Flaxman the artist used Sarah Siddons as his model for the Queen.
- It is recorded that Catherine the Great paid just over £2,700 for her 952-piece Wedgwood dinner and dessert service.

Life was hard and child mortality high. Josiah was nearly twelve when he awoke one day giddy and much disordered covered with an excessive number of spots. It was a virulent attack of smallpox and he was lucky to survive it, but it left him with a severe infection in the right knee. This returned as he grew older, hampering his progress

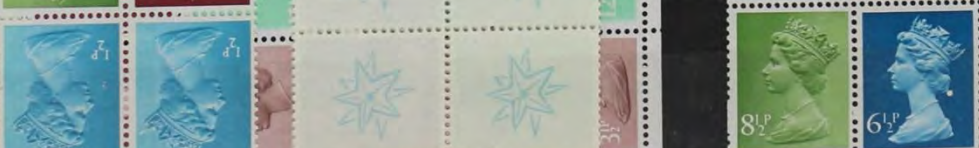
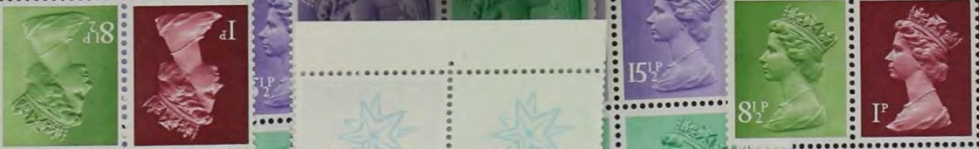


cream-coloured earthenware which pleased her so much that Josiah Wedgwood was granted permission to style himself 'Potter to Her Majesty' and call his creamware 'Queen's Ware'.

**Dinner service for Catherine the Great**  
A few years later the Empress Catherine the Great of Russia ordered a dinner service in Queen's Ware for some two dozen people, decorated in maroon flowers, which was eclipsed in 1774 by the completion of another order placed by the Empress for a huge combined dinner and dessert service for fifty people and which consisted of 952 hand-painted pieces of gardens and English scenery. Today this is kept in the Hermitage Museum, Leningrad where some eighty pieces are on display.

Meanwhile Josiah's personal life had undergone a big ordeal. In 1768 he suffered a severe attack of inflammation on the knee left weak by smallpox. The attack was so serious that amputation was essential. Josiah recovered rapidly, thanks to the care of his wife Sarah, his third cousin whom he had married in 1764. Josiah equipped himself with a wooden leg made by a Mr Addison of Long Acre.

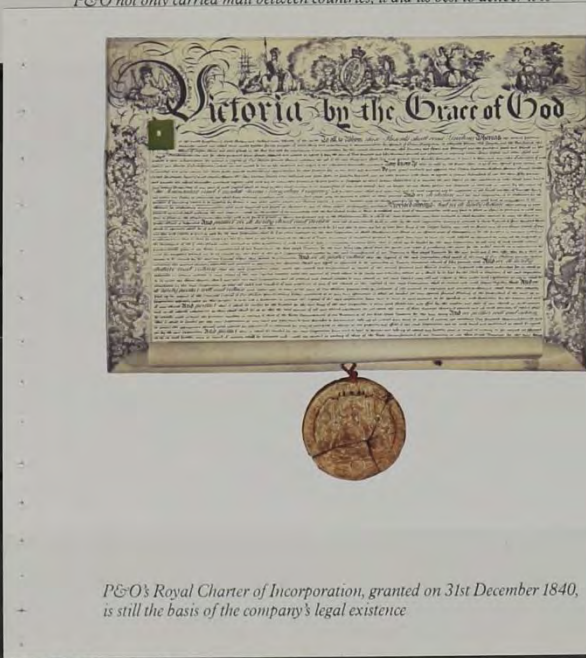

The purses containing the coins are distributed by The Queen on Maundy Thursday to as many elderly men and as many elderly women as there are years in her age.

The Ceremony is based on Our Lord's act of humility when, after the Last Supper he washed the feet of His Disciples. The striking of special coins for



the ceremony continues a tradition which began more than 300 years ago; and Maundy Money is eagerly sought by collectors throughout the world.

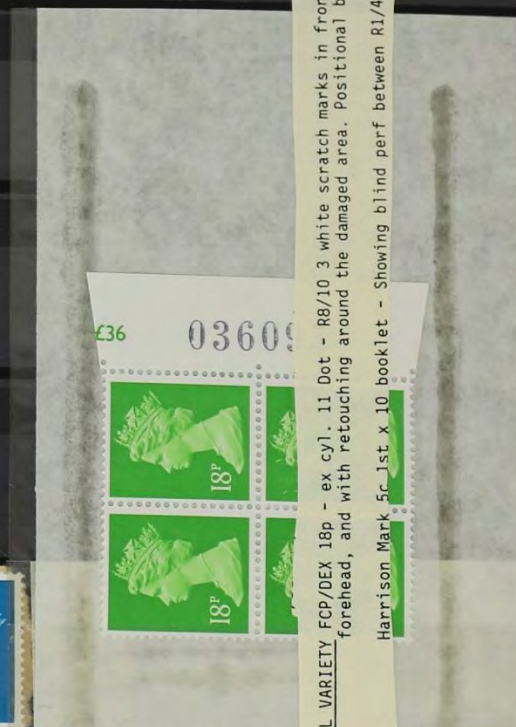

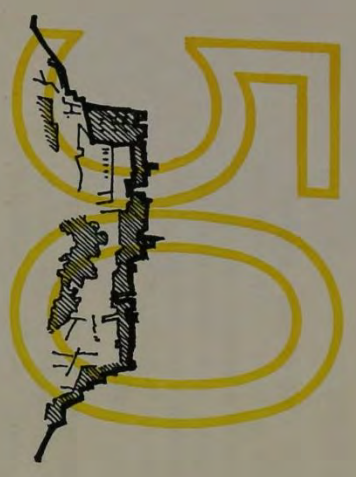
