**What made James Polk a "dark horse" candidate for President?**

Before James Polk (1795-1849) was elected President of the United States in 1844, he was not well known; therefore, he was called a "dark horse" candidate. Formerly, Polk had served in the U.S. House of Representatives and was speaker of the House from 1835 to 1839. He also served one term as governor of Tennessee. He tried twice to run for governor again, but was defeated in both elections. Still, Polk remained interested in politics.

When the Democratic convention met in 1844 to name a candidate for President, the favorite

was thought to be Martin Van Buren. But Van Buren only received about half the votes, not the two-thirds required. But, when Andrew Jackson announced his support for Polk, the convention picked Polk as a compromise candidate. (#2217b)

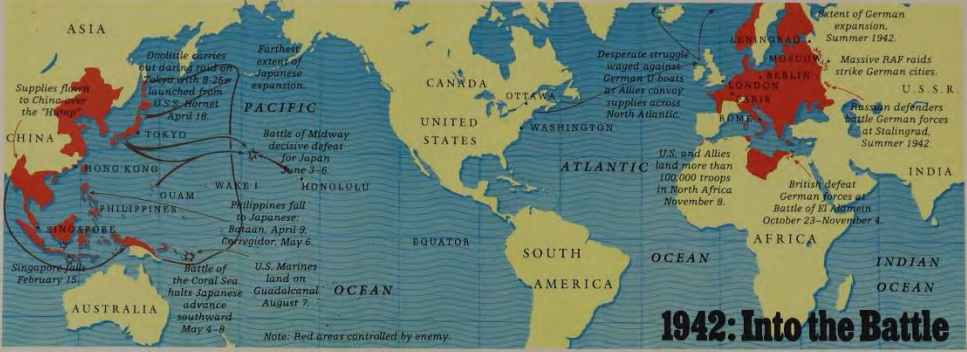

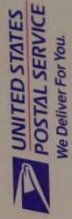

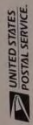

## The Dawn of the Twentieth Century

Sixty percent of Americans lived on farms or in small towns. Immigrants were arriving on an average of 100 an hour. Railroads dominated land travel, but 1900 saw the first U.S. auto show and 1908 the first family transcontinental car trip. In 1908 Henry Ford made automobiles more affordable with the Model T. The Wright brothers stunned the world with their first airplane flight in 1903, and the game of baseball grew up. President Theodore Roosevelt protected 148 million acres as national forests. The first daily comic strip, "Mutt and Jeff," appeared in the *San Francisco Chronicle*. The Ash Can School brought realism back to the art world. Muckrakers exposed corruption: Ida Tarbell revealed monopoly in the oil industry, and Upton Sinclair revealed shocking conditions in the meat industry. In 1909 the newly formed NAACP promoted equal rights for African Americans. New words: cheerleader, filmmaker, phony, psychoanalysis

## The Roaring Twenties

**T**wo Constitutional amendments went into effect in 1920, turning the nation upside down. The 18th Amendment prohibited the manufacture and sale of alcoholic beverages, and the 19th gave women the right to vote. Prohibition backfired, leading to widespread disrespect for the law. A federal highway system was organized and the number of automobiles nearly tripled. Spreading electrification spawned the golden age of radio. The Roaring Twenties, as the decade came to be known, was an age of thrill seekers and heroes. In 1926 Gertrude Ederle swam the English Channel faster than any man had. The following year Charles Lindbergh flew nonstop across the Atlantic alone and Babe Ruth hit 60 home runs. *The Jazz Singer*, appeared in 1927 and the first Academy Awards were presented in 1929. The prosperous times ended with the stock market crash of Thursday, October 24, 1929. New words, motel, robot, fan mail, teenage

### The "Hawaiian Missionary" Stamps of 1851-1853



The first official Hawaiian post office was established in December 1850. Postmaster Henry M. Whitney had stamps printed locally in three denominations. Philatelists call these rare stamps "Hawaiian Missionaries" because virtually all were used by Christian missionaries on outbound mail. Only 28 covers with Missionary stamps are known to exist; only the Dawson cover (right) bears the 2¢ stamp. The two 13¢ stamps were unusual as they prepaid postage in two countries—Hawaii and the U.S.
