LE BIENHEUREUX PERE JACQUES DESIRE LAVAL

Le Père Laval, prêtre catholique français, a débarqué à l'île Maurice en 1841, à l'âge de 38 ans. L'esclavage venait d'être aboli dans cette colonie britannique. La corruption, l'injustice et l'immoralité s'établirent parmi les maîtres. Ses amis étaient la prière ardente, le complet oubli de soi, un profond amour des plus déshérités et une patience sans bornes. Indubitablement, il enseignait la morale et la doctrine catholique et il veillait paternellement à ce qu'on les respecte.

Chaque jour le Père Laval rendait visite à ses "Chers Nègres" dans leurs huttes, à l'hôpital, à la prison. Il fit construire de petites écoles de brocasse et des centres de prière à travers le pays et il veillait à leur bon fonctionnement. D'abord il rencontra beaucoup d'opposition, mais peu à peu il gagna leur confiance. Après cinq années de travail épuisant et solitaire, tous l'accablèrent et voulurent le suivre. C'est alors que sept autres missionnaires français vinrent l'aider et le beau travail continua. Quand il mourut en 1864, après vingt-trois années de ministère, le Père Laval était aimé et admiré de tous. 40.000 Mauriciens (la moitié de la population adulte) accompagnèrent son cercueil.

Aujourd'hui, 125 ans après sa mort, des centaines de pèlerins, de toutes races et croyances, viennent chaque jour prier à son tombeau. Il est, pour l'île Maurice, le symbole de son unité dans sa diversité culturelle, raciale et religieuse.

Le 29 avril 1979, il sera déclaré BIENHEUREUX par Sa Sainteté le Pape. Ce sera la reconnaissance officielle de sa réputation de sainteté et de ses miracles.

BLESSED JACQUES DESIRE LAVAL

Father Laval, a French Roman Catholic priest, came to Mauritius in 1841, at the age of 38. Slavery had been recently abolished in this British Colony. Corruption, injustice and immorality were rampant. Neither the freed slaves nor their paid masters were exempt. Could one man alone lead 60,000 Mauricians to a better way of life? His arms were ardent prayer, daily self-sacrifice, a profound love of all men and unrelenting patience. His method was to visit religious principles and see that they led to correct behaviour.

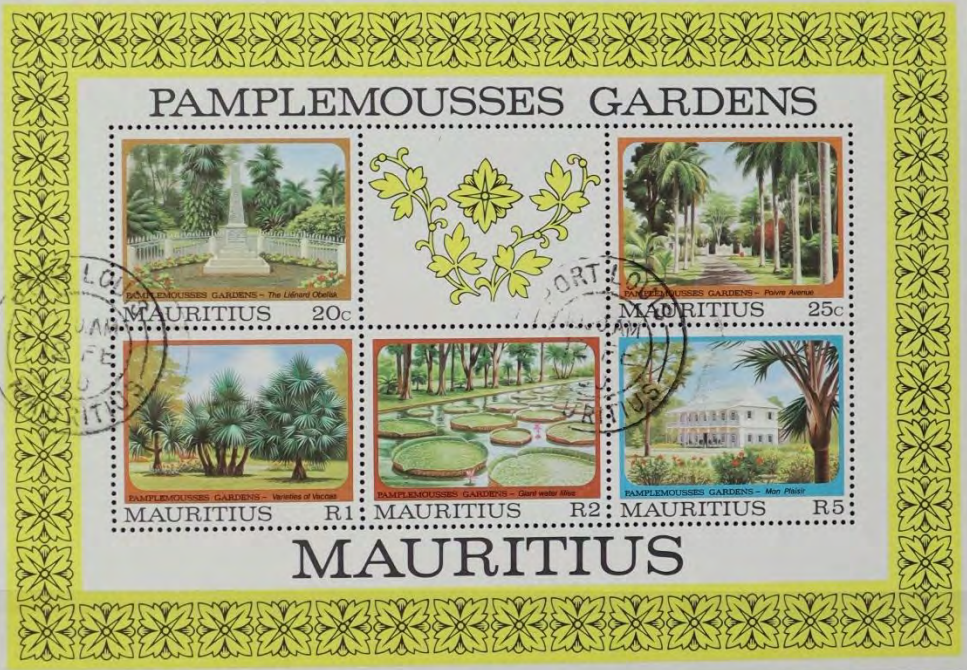
Responsible mainly for the coloured population, Father Laval visited them in their huts, in the hospital, in the prison. He built bush schools and prayer centres near the capital and then further afield. He instructed the natives, never taking sufficient food or sleep. Bit by bit, he overcame their mistrust and even hatred. During the first five years, he was completely alone and his valiant efforts won him the esteem of all. Then seven French missionary priests came to help him and the good work flourished. When he died in 1864, after 23 years of tenacious effort, he was admired and loved by everyone. 40,000 Mauricians (half the adult population), grateful and sorrowing, followed his coffin.

Today 125 years after his death, hundreds of pilgrims, of every race and creed, come daily to pray at his tomb. His invaluable presence is a source of unity, peace and brotherhood.

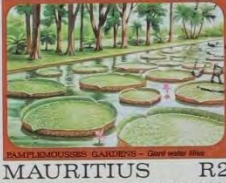
On April 29th 1979, he is to be proclaimed BLESSED by his Holiness the Pope. This will be the official recognition of his saintly life and of his miracles.
