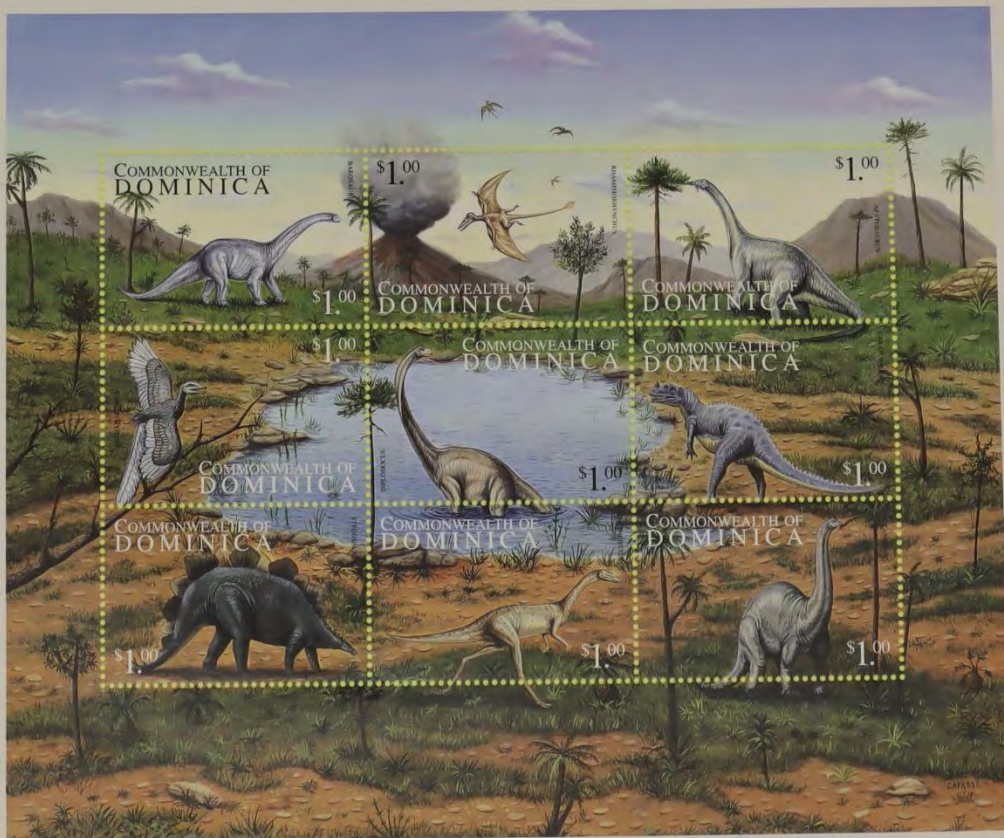

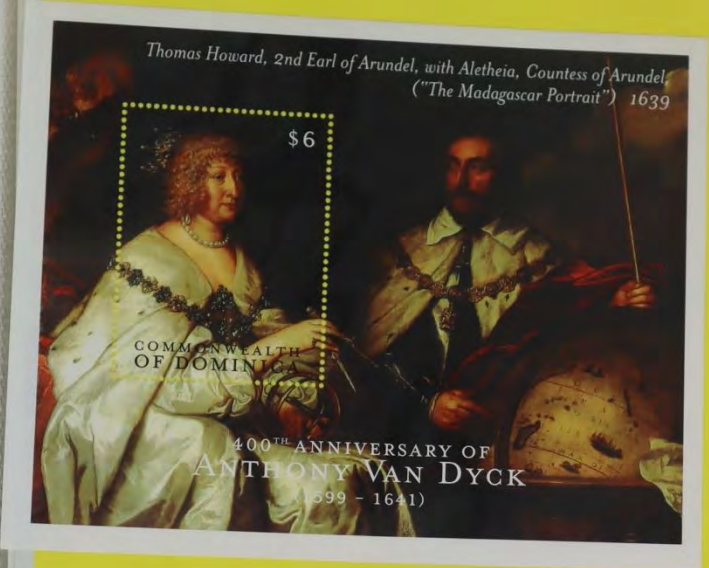

DRAGON IN THE MIST
CHEN RONG, SONG DYNASTY (11TH CENTURY)

SERVING AS A HIGH RANKING OFFICIAL IN THE COURT AND GOVERNOR OF FU-TIEN, CHEN RONG WAS VERY TROUBLED BY THE DETERIORATING SONG GOVERNMENT. HE OFTEN EXPRESSED HIS FRUSTRATION THROUGH POETRY AND PAINTING. HE WAS KNOWN ESPECIALLY FOR HIS PAINTINGS OF DRAGONS. THIS PAINTING DEPICTS A DRAGON FLYING IN THE MIST. THE ANIMATED LINE WORK ON CONTOUR ECHOES WITH THE PAINTER'S BRUSH STROKES ON BACKGROUND. STYLIZED WITH REALISTIC DETAIL, IT HIGHLIGHTS THE SPECIAL POSITION THAT CHEN RONG'S DRAGON PAINTINGS HAS IN CHINESE ART HISTORY.

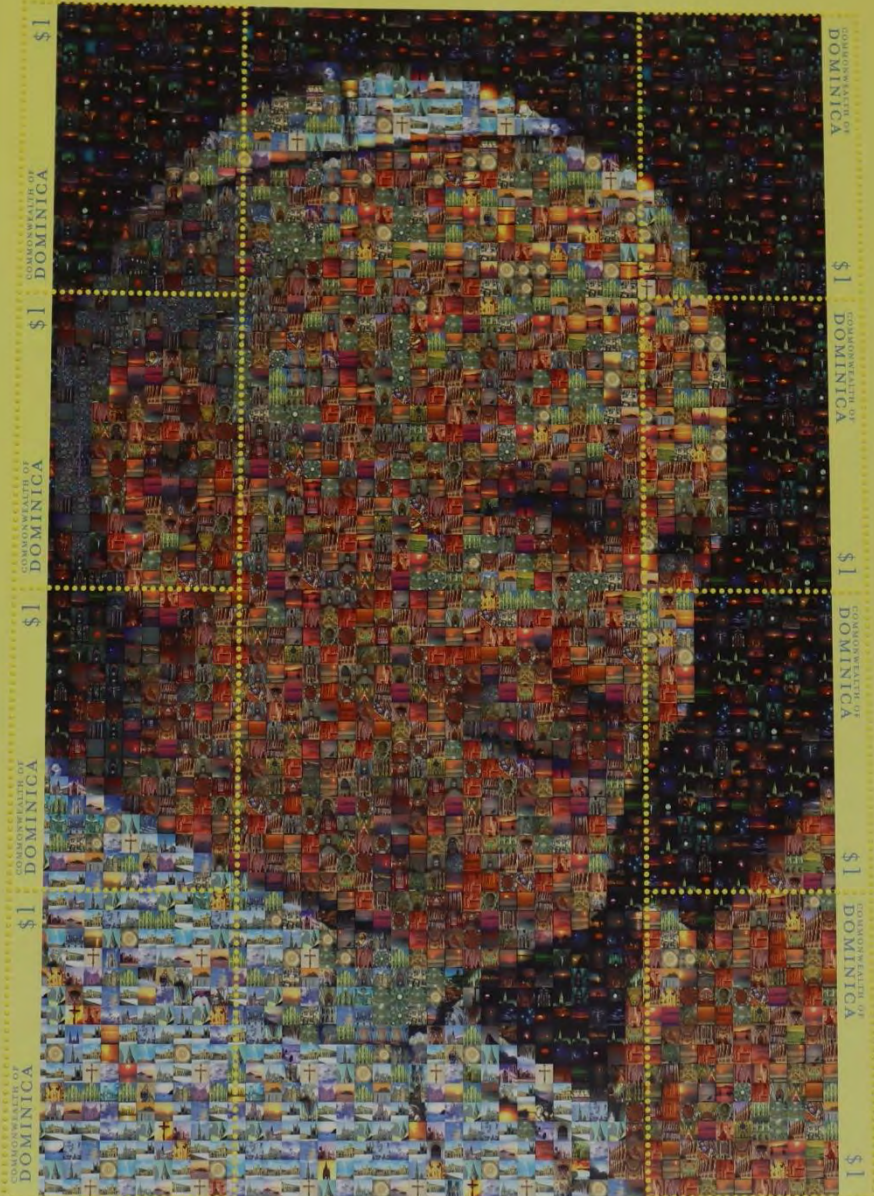

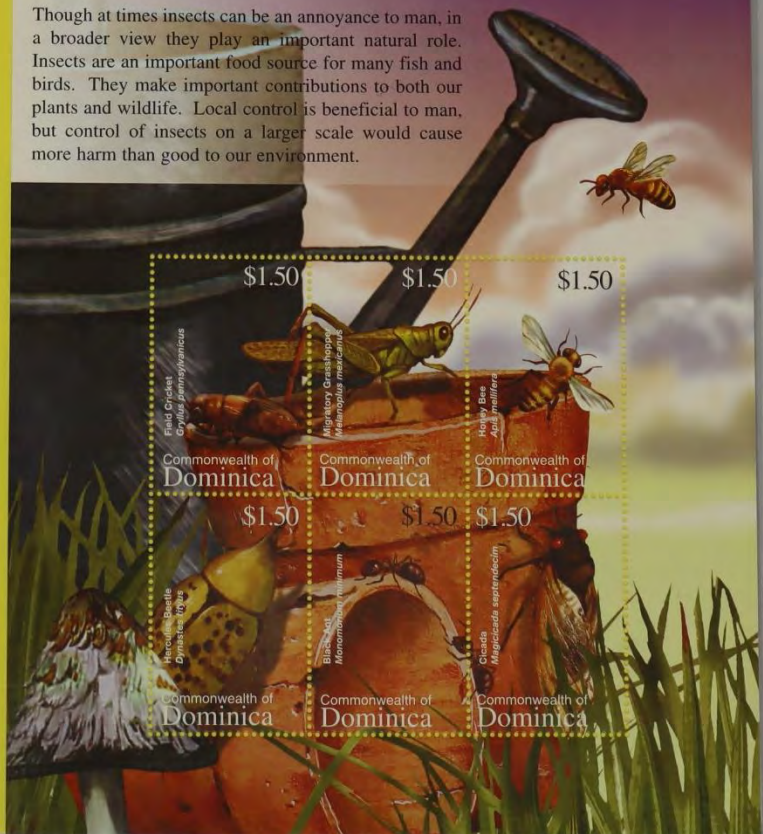

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born in Salzburg, Austria, 27 January 1756. He died in Vienna on 5 December 1791. Considered one of the greatest musical geniuses of all time, he authored over 600 works before his premature death at the age of 35.

The son of an orchestra leader, Leopold Mozart, he showed remarkable musical talent early in life, playing the harpsichord by the age of 4, composing music at 5, and performing his first recital at the age of 6 for the Empress of Austria. In his short life he composed masterpieces in every genre of music known to him, including symphonies, chamber music, church music, operas and operettas—most of which are still famous today. His legacy of music is incredible, not just in numbers, but in diversity. His untimely passing was the world's loss, and, ironically, despite his brilliance as a composer, and despite his fame and position in the Austrian Emperor's Court, Mozart was buried in a pauper's grave.
