Surcharged or overprinted stamps, 50 per cent. over the above rates.

For stamps condemned (forgeries, reprints, cleaned, repaired, &c.), half the above fees only will be charged, but no photographs are given.

In addition to the above, the Committee are prepared to examine mixed lots of stamps at a fee of 6d. per stamp up to £2 catalogus value and 1s. per stamp for those over £2 and up to £5.

They must be mounted on sheets with sufficient room left above each stamp to mark "G" (genuine), or "F" (forgery), or "R" (repaired), or "Rep." (reprint), &c.

The above fees are those charged to members and associates. For stamps submitted by others, an increase of 33½ per cent. on the above fees.
